- history of ASSITEJ
- current president: Yvette Hardie
- We had a small meeting at Krokusfestival 2014 about the possibility of ASSITEJ Belgium, that was founded in 2015.

Mission: see website

The asbl/vzw is a structure to make our work possible

In 2015, we had a meeting at Krokusfestival: Kickoff – start with 110 people. Vigdis Jakobsdottier and Sue Giles from the board of ASSITEJ International were invited – they talked about the networks and activities

- → first time that that amount of people came together from the 2 sides of the country + are interested to collaborate. ASSITEJ can be a tool to get to know each other. This has been our main focus recently: how can we get to know the 3 different communities? International part can be more imporant in the future, but let us also work on the national part: 2 gatherings/year: Hasselt (Krokus), Namur (Turbulences), Brussels (Bronks)
- → 10 companies are always invited to present themselves We want to continue this.

At the national gathering at Turbulences, there were company presentations, a speed date and workshops.

The idea is to always link a national gathering to an existing festival.

- There are worldwide ASSITEJ Artistic Gatherings every year: the next one is in Birmingham – festival On the edge – from July 2 - 9

We will send 2 young artists there: Jennifer El Gammal and Margot de Ley will go there and will make a report for our website.

National Gathering on 11 November - Export/Import @ BRONKS

Question: international presentation will be a topic: reflect and think, what are the challenges ...

there is some money to invite some people from abroad. There are also a lot of international programmers at the festival anyway.

Input from the assemblee: what would you like to be discussed?

- to have both the presentation of a festival director and from a company who went to that festival
- Sibiu Festival Romania: they are developing for young audiences would be interesting to connect with them, is a huge festival http://www.sibfest.ro/sibiu-international-theatre-festival.html
- structures that do both, for ex BRONKS. Maybe invite someone who is both producing and presenting
- How do other companies arrange the financial part of international touring? → know more about practical issues, do they have an all-in fee etc, how do they arrange transport etc.
- → interesting to know!
- language issue: are there ways to create something around this: translating, subtitling ... Pick up one or 2 shows a year and have the text translated + produced by a Flemish/French-speaking organisation
- interesting areas / countries ...: Germany, France, Russia: Yannick gave a presentation in Russia.

The Gavroche festival (Moscow) is another festival that always focuses on one country and is intereseted in work from Belgium. Another festival in Velikiy Novgorod (South of St Petersburg) which is a biennale - http://www.eng.kingfestival.ru/maly/. Coordinator: Tatiana Bobrova. She is also vice-President of Assitej Russia. Application for the 2017 until December 1st.

Ideas for 2017

- World Congress every 3 years: next year, it will be in Cape Town (May)
- as for activities, everything is still open
- activities we present, are for members only
- we might have more contacts with other ASSITEJ centres of other countries
- idea of a bus trip in Belgium for the members, visit certain places ...
- → for ex start in Ghent you can visit for example a social artistic company, another company of Ghent, see some shows, then go to St. Vith and participate in the festival ... could last 3 days visit another town each day more inspiring than just talking about your work, is showing it not only big structures, also small companies & artists

what is the best time to do this?

- → not in May (Capetown), June: people are preparing for Les Rencontres de Huy, September: after the 15th, after the Rencontres
- in Spring 2017, we can do another meeting

Any themes members want to discuss?

→ examples of partnerships between organisations from the different communities, sharing examples of organisations who worked together (FroeFroe and 4 Mains were presented at Krokus already). There are not many examples yet ...

Other examples of collaborations, not only production

see website Cultureel Akkoord / Accord Culturel: which projects got money? for ex Bizar – De Kolonie MT and 4 Mains \rightarrow we could invite them

Residential workshop with artists for different days – from the different communities

Félizette Chazerand proposes to do a workshop with kabinet k

Issues for 2017

- relationship with schools and students who will become teachers
- → exchange, learn from each other
- might be interesting to invite some directors of ASSITEJ centres from around the world to let them explain what it is all about
